Summary of Incident:

On Wednesday, March 17, 2010 at approximately 1719 hours, inmate Peggy Bean W/F 1250340 expired at the Taylor Regional Hospital in Hawkinsville, Georgia. The suspected cause of death is listed as Necrosis of the small bowel. Bean had been transported to Taylor Regional Hospital via state van on Tuesday, March 16, 2010 by Officer Audrey Whitten at approximately 1513 hours. Bean was suffering with a small bowel obstruction. At 1559, Bean was admitted to Taylor Regional Hospital Intensive Care Unit # 4. At approximately 2257, inmate Bean underwent emergency surgery. At 0046 the attending physician advised that Bean's approximately 2257, inmate Bean underwent emergency surgery. At 0046 the attending physician advised that Bean's situation was grave and that she could possibly expire within the hour. However, Bean did survive into the next day. Officer Debra Goolsby assumed post at the hospital on Wednesday, March 17, 2010 at approximately 1435 hours. Upon her arrival, Some of Bean's family members were present to visit with Bean. These family members had prior authorization to visit Bean while she was hospitalized. Dr. Lawton of TRH limited the number of visitors to two at a time due to Bean's condition. They were advised that Bean had undergone Emergency Surgery on 03/16/2010 due to her deteriorating condition. At this time Bean was on life support. Bean's Mother, Father, Sisters, brother, brother-in-law, Aunt, and Nephew were all approved to visit with her. The attending physician, Dr. Lawton spoke with Bean's family and advised them of her
