Summary of Incident:

On 03/26/13, inmate Virginia Wilson, B/F, 77410 expired at the Taylor Regional Hospital Emergency Room, Hawkinsville, Georgia at 2305 hours. Wilson had been transported to the hospital via EMS ambulance earlier at 2200 hours. The inmate was experiencing difficulty breathing in dorm E7. The officer contacted the medical section about the inmate's condition. Louise Linkhorn, LPN and Jennifer Dancy, LPN responded to the scene and transported Wilson to the medical section for treatment. Upon arrival there, the charge nurse Ruth Beamon, RN examined Wilson and called institutional physician, Dr. Ivon Nazaire of the inmate's condition. Dr. Nazaire at this time ordered that the inmate be placed in the infirmary on 23 hours observation due to the inmate being scheduled for [REDACTED] the following day. She was placed in infirmary cell #A1-176. Her condition began to decline and Dr. Nazaire was contacted. Dr. Nazaire issued orders to contact Taylor Regional Hospital via 911. Nurse Beamon contacted the security OIC, Lt. Drucilla Rawls and advised that the EMT's were en route to the facility to transport Wilson to the local hospital. The EMT's arrived at 2200 hours. Wilson was transported via ambulance at 2237 to Taylor Regional Hospital with Officer Lucy Coley as the escort officer inside the ambulance and Officer Quentin Battle following in a state van. The ambulance arrived at the hospital emergency room at 2253 hours. The medical staff continued with medical care until the inmate expired. Emergency room Doctor Lou Perino pronounced inmate Wilson dead at 2305
